## Forest House Education Centre - The Range visit

Many pupils love the products at The Range, especially the Halloween and Christmas themed decorations, and so FHEC pupils visited the store in St Albans where they met one of the managers who spoke with them about the company, its history, competitors, and how preparing the store for seasonal success works. He also spoke about what skills employers look for in employees, and was very impressed with the questions which the group put to him and another colleague who looks after the in-store Iceland section.



Reminder of some key skills employers look for - we encourage your young people to proactively think about demonstrating these especially offsite:

**Confidence and Communication:** Both verbal and written communication, including public speaking and interpersonal skills.

**Teamwork and collaboration:** The ability to work effectively with others and be a reliable team member.

**Problem-solving:** The ability to identify issues and find effective solutions.

**Adaptability:** Being flexible and open to change in a workplace setting.

**Time management:** Organising and prioritising tasks to meet deadlines.

**Leadership:** The ability to guide and motivate others, which can include skills like decision-making and planning.

**Critical thinking:** Analysing information objectively to make reasoned judgments.

**Creativity:** Generating new ideas and approaching problems with originality.

**Work ethic:** Motivation, strong dedication, reliability, and a professional attitude.

## Roman Fields - Year 11 Britvic Trip

Learning how J20 drinks are crafted from a base product and then enhanced with different natural flavours to reach the perfect taste was what the Year 11 pupils from RFA enjoyed during a morning at Carlsberg Britvic in Hemel Hempstead. Our young people worked in a live laboratory setting supported by graduate scientists to produce two bottles each of their favourite flavours which they later revealed to others to taste - let's just say some were very different to what we might buy on the supermarket shelves!

The staff from Carlsberg Britvic explained about the history of the company, the brands in the portfolio such as Pepsi, Fruit Shoot and Robinsons, and were impressed by our pupils' curiosity in their questions around many aspects of science. Our pupils also demonstrated many of the employability skills which employers look for such as confidence, adaptability and team work. More on those later.





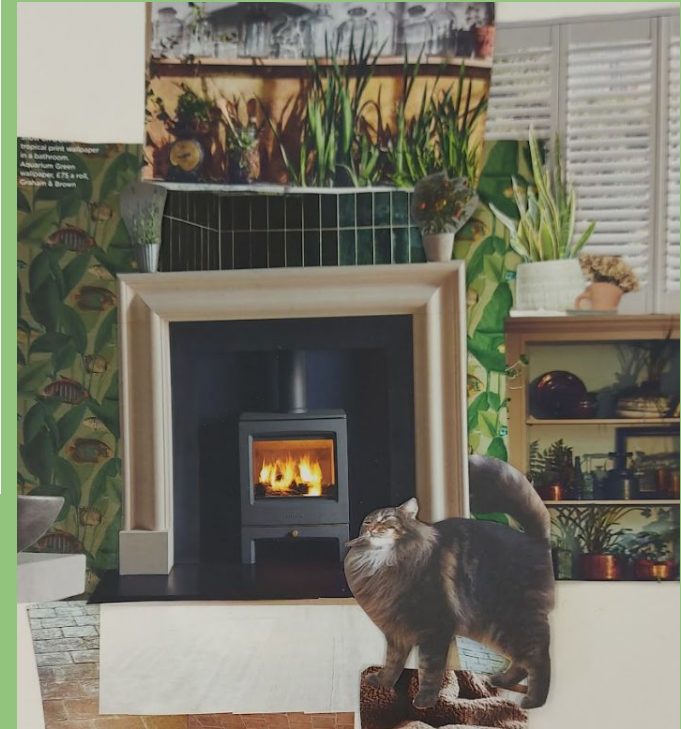

## Roman Fields - Tesco apprenticeship talk

Paul, who is our enterprise adviser from Tesco (fondly known to all as Tesco Paul) recently spent some time getting to know our RFA Year 9 pupils and they were set a task called the 'breakfast meal deal challenge'. The challenge was to produce a deal similar to the traditional lunch meal deal and each product had to include at least 5 ingredients and one item which would normally go to waste. Paul talked about sustainability, reducing food waste and the 4 Rs of packaging: remove, reduce, reuse and recycle. The pupils created posters showing their great ideas.

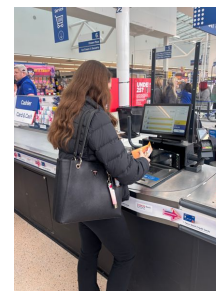
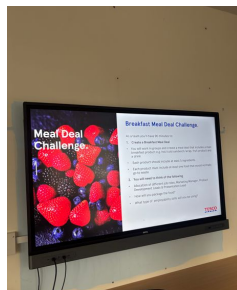
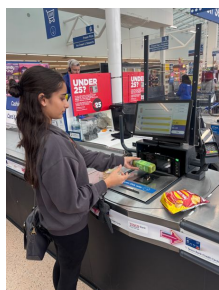
Paul then took the Year 10 pupils to Tesco at Jarman Park where they learnt more about the store (top selling products, store targets, salaries) and then we enjoyed a brief tour of some parts such as the online deliveries and clothing and scanned our own lunch meal deal items!

Paul also emphasised the skills which employers like Tesco look for - more on this later.

Later that day, Nicole, our adviser from Services for Young People gave the annual statutory apprenticeship and technical provider talk to RFA pupils followed by Tesco Paul talking about the apprenticeship schemes which Tesco offers.

Paul will be visiting JMA on Thursday 4th December to work with the Year 8 and 9 pupils and this will be followed by the same statutory apprenticeship talk with Nicole from Services for Young People which will also include the Year 10s and 13s. He will work with the Year 10 pupils later in the academic year.

Nicole will be visiting Forest House on Tuesday 25th November to give the same talk.

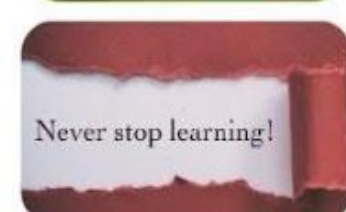
